The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), Solid Waste Unit, received and reviewed the *Restrictive Covenant, Request for Approval to Construct Improvements Yavapai County Criminal*, dated June 11, 2020. Moreover, the City of Prescott submitted a letter dated June 11, 2020 in support of the approval of the subject request by Yavapai County.

As indicated in your correspondence, the proposed improvements are to be constructed on an undisturbed portion of property which is located outside of the footprint of the Sundog Ranch Road landfill and do not disturb the landfill cap or interfere with potential future monitoring activities and do not negatively impact the storm water managements associated with the landfill itself.
